Public Notice #2 2020 Coronavirus Response

What's Open and What's Not Town of Douglas Buildings As of Monday, March 16, 2020

The following summarizes the status of various Town buildings as of 1:00 P.M. on Monday, March 16, 2020. This document will be updated if and when the information changes.

- Douglas Public Schools: per the order of the Governor, all schools in Massachusetts are closed until April 7, 2020
- Douglas Municipal Center:
 - Gymnasium: closed until further notice.
 - Town Hall functions: open to the public. Residents requested to use on-line bill payment function and to refrain from starting new permit applications to reduce foot traffic in the common spaces of the building.
 - Police Station: open to the public.
- Fire Station: open to the public.
- Adult Social Center: closed to the public. Staff continue to work inside and will answer phone calls and emails during regular business hours.
- Simon Fairfield Public Library: Until further notice, the Library is providing circulation service only at the front door. All programs and events are cancelled and only staff are allowed inside the building past the foyer. Interlibrary loan has been suspended. Please place all returns in the book drop outside.
- Playgrounds: open to the public.

Patrons frequenting buildings that remain open to the public are asked to refrain from doing so if they have a combination of dry cough and fever or have been exposed to someone with COVID-19, or potentially exposed by traveling in an area where the coronavirus is present. Patrons are further requested to practice “social distancing” and hand washing when inside public buildings or using public facilities.
